1. Update, discussion, and direction to staff on the Drainage Master Plan.

Dan Franz and Erica Nordstrom, Halff Associates - Upon receipt of all information and close of public information gathering, Halff has identified approximately 21 projects localized throughout the City for consideration as part of the Master Plan efforts. Halff requested direction from Council for riverine locations; whether to fix the identified riverine locations with no change or to a 5-yr, 10-yr, 25-yr, 50-yr, or 100-yr loss of service, or place a monitoring system on any of the locations. Feedback was requested from the Fire Department and the Police Department on their preferred or more often taken route. After further information from staff is collected, this item will be brought back at a future date.
