## **Taylor Police Make Arrest in Shooting**

TAYLOR, Texas – On Monday, 6/1/20 at approximately 1:35 AM, Taylor Officers heard multiple shots fired in the 400 block of Burkett Street, and observed a vehicle immediately fleeing from the area. Officers stopped the vehicle in the 300 block of N. Main St. and identified three subjects in the vehicle. John Marshall, Jr., 26 years of Taylor, was in the back seat of the vehicle, along with a revolver that had 6 spent bullet casings in it.

Taylor Dispatch advised officers that a resident in the 400 block of Burkett Street called, stating that John Marshall Jr. just shot up the house. The driver of the vehicle advised that they were driving down Burkett St. when John Marshall Jr. rolled down the back window, shot multiple times at the residence on Burkett St., and then fled the scene before being stopped by officers.

Criminal Investigation Division Detectives responded, interviewed the subjects, and located 3 rounds at the residence. John Marshall Jr. was arrested and charged with Deadly Conduct, a third-degree felony, as he knowingly discharged a firearm at or in the direction of a habitation. Officers will consult with the Williamson County District Attorney's Office on additional charges that may be pending.

There were no reports of injuries.

One of the bullets that was discharged was retrieved in the bedroom where a baby was asleep. If the bullet would have been about 8" lower, it would have struck the sleeping baby.
